## Go live instructions

Thanks for choosing a Zitecraft website! ebsite!

In order to connect the “zite” to your domain name a couple of steps need to be made:

1. Log in via <http://zitecraft.com/login>. At the first login Facebook will ask you to provide permission to Zitecraft.
2. Fill out the domain name without “<http://>” in the “Domain Name & Payments” tab.
3. Tick the box: “I do own this domain, and I can set the DNS 'A' record appropriately:”
4. Now the domain needs to point tot he IP address of the Zitecraft server. This should be done by logging in at the service provider where the domain is registered. On most domain websites this can be done via a link called “Change DNS” or “Change DNS records”. We recommend asking the helpdesk of the service provider where and how this should be done.

5. If A records of these types are already present they need to be edited overwriting the IP address (always write down the old settings for in case things go wrong).
6. Your domain service provider can also change the DNS settings for you.
7. Email accounts on the domain keep working like before, nothing needs to be changed fort his (Zitecraft only provides the website hosting).
8. Go back to the Zitecraft CMS for the payment.  
A monthly subscription can be choosen, the payment can be made with creditcard or iDeal. By making the first payment you grant Zitecraft permission to withdraw the amount every month.  
When paying per year the payment can also be done via Paypal and no automatic withdraw will be done after 12 months.
9. After paying your zite will automatically be set to “Active”, at the bottom of the screen at “Current status of domainlinking for this Zite:”.
10. It can take up to 30 minutes to a couple of hours untill your zite is live and until that moment the old website is shown in the browser. It can also differ per device how quickly the nbew website is visible.
